Annual General Meeting

As already advised in the last Newsletter, the Annual General Meeting of the Association will take place in the Crypt at 1.45 p.m. on Saturday 5th July, immediately prior to the rehearsal for evensong. Nearly 30 members have expressed their intention to attend and this is very heartening.

The 2008 Reunion

After the AGM there will be a rehearsal in the Cathedral with the Cathedral Choir commencing at 3.00pm followed by tea in the crypt at 3.40. Over 100 members and their guests will attend Evensong, some 32 wishing to sing.

If you are not attending the AGM, but are singing at Evensong please be at the Cathedral by no later than 2.45 in order to be seated. Please follow the signs and directions by the stewards.

Immediately after Evensong all members should move swiftly to the Presbytery Steps for the photographs. Members and their guests will then be invited to the Dean's Garden for the Reception, or the Refectory if wet, where you will be able to register your attendance and collect your name tag.

During the reception members are invited to visit the 'lost boys & girls' table to view a number of photographs and members listings. It is hoped that we will be able to identify names to faces and even the whereabouts of 'missing' former colleagues. Maureen Adams & Miggie Sharp have very kindly offered to manage the registration process and the missing persons lists.

There is no charge for the reunion or the reception however, recognising that some of our members are better off financially than others, collection plates will be placed in prominent positions and we should be grateful for a donation to our funds.

Events Manager. The primary responsibility is to manage our annual fund raising events, the first of which will now be in Q1-2009.

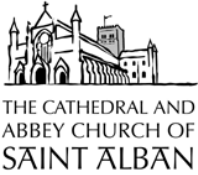
