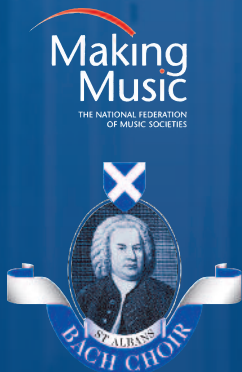

# DR PETER HURFORD OBE

## IN CELEBRATION OF HIS 80TH BIRTHDAY



Our concert celebrates a man who has been inextricably bound up with the musical life of St Albans for over 50 years. Peter Hurford, who will be 80 in November, has been Master of the Music at St Albans Cathedral, Music Director of St Albans Bach Choir, Founder of the International Organ Festival and world-renowned concert organist and recording artist, known particularly for his recordings of the complete organ works of J S Bach. In the early 1960s he also co-designed the magnificent St Albans Cathedral organ, the renovation of which was completed last year.

As the music of J S Bach has been central to Peter Hurford's life's work, it is only fitting that the concert should feature three of Bach's best known choral works. In recognition of Peter Hurford's distinguished career as an organist, the concert also features Handel's Organ Concerto Op.4 no.4, with the organ solo played by Margaret Phillips.



### Our Soloists:

**Julie Cooper** is a regular member of The Sixteen and The King's Consort who perform all over the world. An extremely versatile soprano who is much in demand for her Baroque and Renaissance repertoire, appearing regularly at the Wigmore Hall, Julie has also made numerous CD recordings.



**Tim Travers-Brown** appeared with us earlier this year as a memorable Solomon. As a counter-tenor he sings with many of Europe's foremost choirs and ensembles, including The Monteverdi Choir, Tenebrae and The Gabrieli Consort. He is also a Professor of Vocal Studies at Trinity College, London.



Tenor **Christopher Lemmings** is not only acclaimed for his Baroque repertoire but has also forged a strong reputation for his work in twentieth-century and contemporary music, performing at the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, and Glyndebourne.



Bass **Stephen Roberts** needs no introduction, having sung with us many times before. His career has seen notable successes on the opera stage as well as on the concert platform and over the years he has been a popular artist at the Royal Albert Hall for Proms concerts.
